

## Gearing Up

The Albert Lea Public Works Department is gearing up for another summer of road improvement projects.

This year's Neighborhood Improvement Projects have been selected and will undergo the mill and overlay process. Those streets, depicted on the maps to the right, are chosen based on their age. The work done extends the life of the road.

Johnson Street from Valley Avenue to the City Beach will be completely reconstructed along with new utility service (shown on the bottom map in purple). Vinehurst Avenue will have a complete replacement of curb, sidewalk and pavement.

Other 2018 proposed improvements include:

- Bay Oaks Drive (cul de sac to Hwy 13)
- The public parking lots on St. Mary's Avenue (behind the Eagle's and Nancy's Cafe)
- Sidewalk replacement in the areas adjacent to Broadway
- Margaretha Avenue from 8th Street to Broadway
- Areas of Plaza Street

Carryover projects from 2017 include finishing the realignment of Plaza Street and the final bituminous layers of Lake Avenue and College Street will be applied.
