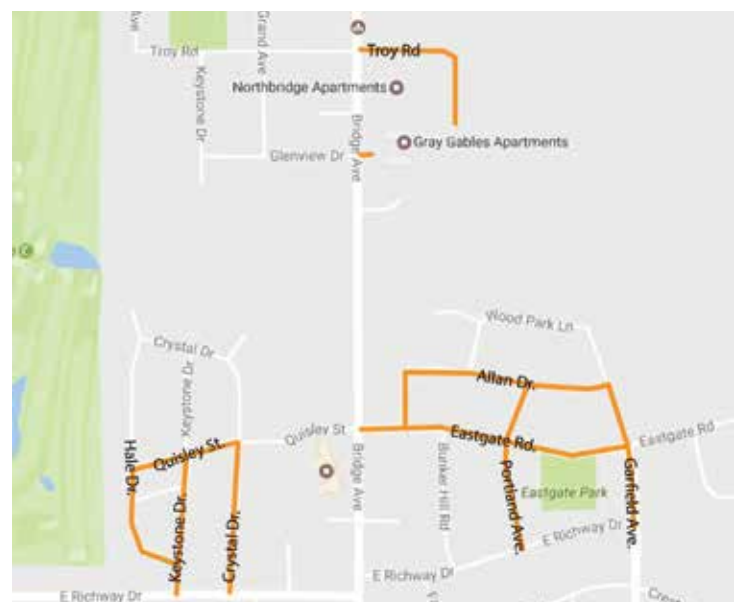
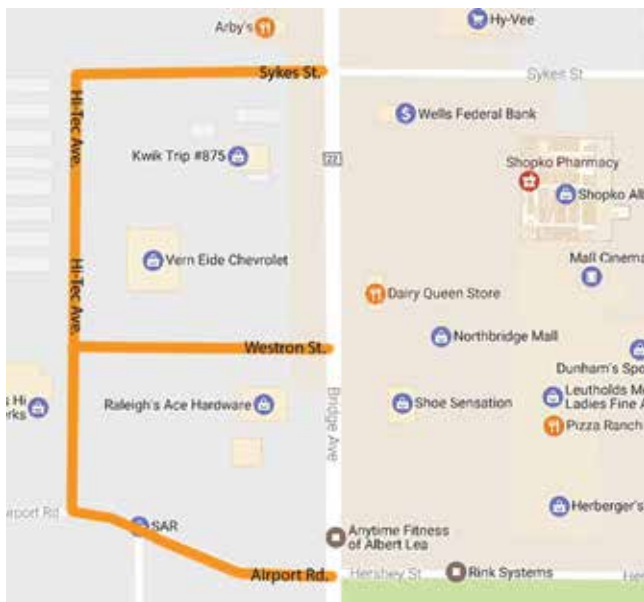
The Albert Lea Public Works Department is always striving to improve our infrastructure, creating a better experience for our motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians.

Public Works staff spends the summer overseeing the reconstruction of roads, sidewalks and alleys. In addition to complete rebuilds, the Department also performs work to maintain our roads like chip sealing and crack sealing. Neighborhood Improvement Projects are also selected and conducted. Those streets, depicted on the maps below, are chosen based on their age. The work done on these projects extends the life of the road.

Other major 2017 proposed improvements include:

- The Transfer Station and Demolition Landfill Road
- The frontage road on the north side of East Main
- Plaza Street Relocation west of Bridge
- Sunset from Highway 13 to Lakeview Blvd.
- Lake Avenue from Clark Street to Elizabeth Ave.
- E. College St. from Newton Ave. to 200 ft. East of Elizabeth Ave.

Freeborn County will be resurfacing Bridge from Hammer Rd. to I-90 and South Broadway from Highway 65 to County Road 13. Bridge, from Hammer Rd. to Marshall St. is scheduled for reconstruction in 2020.

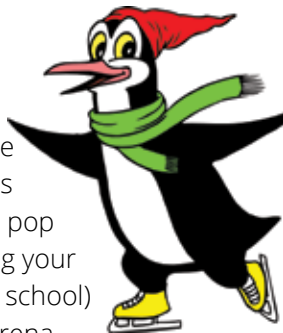
Children must wear a \*Park & Rec trip shirt unless accompanied by an adult - Register by March 10th

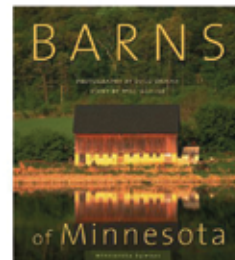
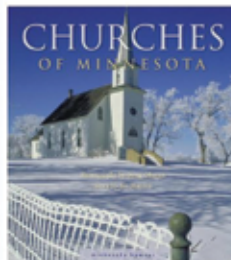
## Minnesota's Byways with Doug Ohman
